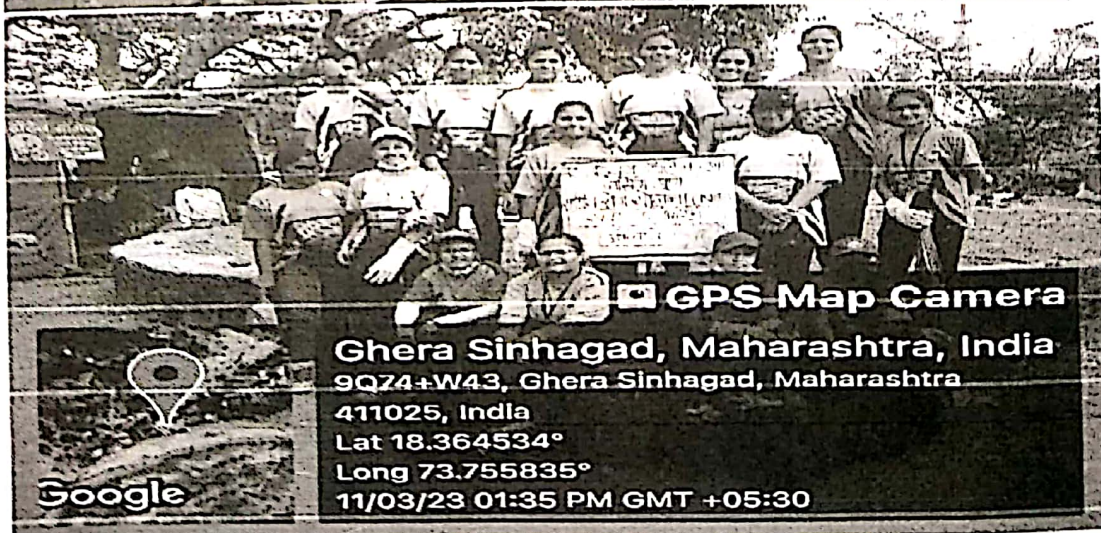
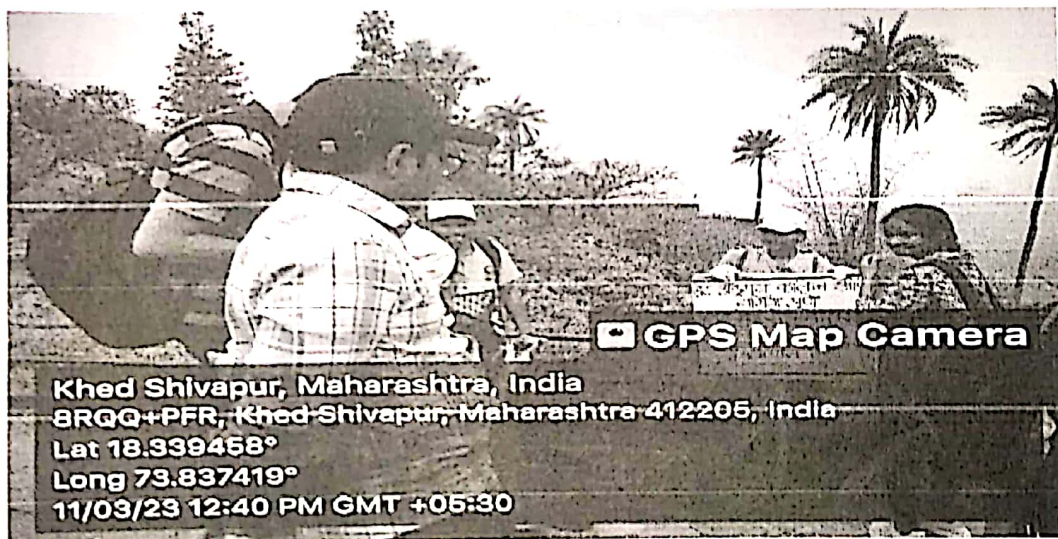
The college bus along with students and faculty was departed from Alibaug at 6.30 pm and arrived to pune by 11.00pm
